



MSORV Business Meeting Fall 2015

The Fall 2015 MSORV meeting was held on October 21, 2015 at UES, Inc. in Dayton, OH and hosted by Pam Lloyd. There were 11 vendors present representing our corporate sponsors and 35 attendees present. The afternoon began with registration and a reception sponsored by FEI and MSORV while attendees networked and visited with vendors. Dave Tomlin, MSORV President-elect, opened the meeting with the welcoming remarks and then introduced Jeanette Killius, Past-President of MSA. Jeanette gave an overview of MSA Membership Benefits and talked about the upcoming M&M 2016 meeting in Columbus, OH. Cathy Johnson, Past-President of MAS gave a brief overview of MAS Membership benefits and the upcoming joint meeting of M&M. The talks began promptly at 4:20PM and stayed on schedule. The speakers for the afternoon Mark Kelsey of Bruker Nano, Inc. and Helmut Gnaegi of DiaTome. Mark's talk was "Tomography: What You See Depends on How Deep You Go" and Helmut's talk was "State of the Art Ultramicrotomy in Biology and Materials Research".

The business meeting was called to order by our President-elect, Dave Tomlin. Minutes of the Spring 2015 meeting were not read but duly noted to the members that they were on-line at the MSORV website, www.msorv.org. Remarks from the MSORV treasurer, Henk Colijn stated that our finances were in good shape with over \$12.5K in assets between a savings and checking account prior to expenses from this meeting. Scholarship travel awards were paid in the amount of \$2K for student travel to M&M. If anyone is interested in seeing actual numbers, please contact Henk Colijn. A motion was made, seconded, and duly passed to accept the Secretary's minutes and Treasurer's report.

It was decided that students will be given up to \$1K including registration if they present at M&M and are a member of MSORV. They must provide receipts for reimbursements.

The election results were announced for the new officers of MSORV. President, Richard Edelmann; Secretary, Matt Duley; and Treasurer, Henk Colijn.

The Spring 2016 MSORV meeting site and date has not been decided. As soon as a place and date are chosen, it will be posted up on the MSORV website. Henk is looking into OSU as well as other options are being explored. If anyone would like to host for the Spring or in the future, please let one of the officers know.

Bruker donated an outdoor chair for a raffle. Jeanette Killius pulled the name and Vicky Bryg was the winner.

With no further business to discuss, the Business Meeting was adjourned at 5:25PM.
